A PAIR OF CLASSIC LOUNGE CHAIRS BY EXTRAORDINARY DANISH FURNITURE DESIGNER FINN JUHL, MODEL 136

This pair of teak lounge chairs with a fabric seat and "floating" back upholstered in a winter white fabric is one of the most technical and sophisticated of Finn Juhl's designs. These chairs with clear reference to his earlier work with cabinet maker Niels Vodder were given the name "Model 136" and were designed in 1956 and manufactured in the 1960s by France & Damp; Søn, and they have maker's metal plaque to prove this. Finn Juhl is considered to be one of the most influential Danish Modern furniture designers and in our view, this is one of the most attractive of his lounge chairs with a very bold and timeless design featuring a sculpted solid teak frame with equally sculpted seat cushions that appear to float above the frame on brass supports.
